III. EVIDENCE DEMONSTRATING THAT THE PETITIONER IS A VICTIM OF A SEVERE FORM OF TRAFFICKING

- Airline tickets, if applicable
- Employment authorization card, if applicable
- Copy of employment contract, if applicable
- Affidavits (a notarized statement), declarations (a statement signed under penalty of perjury), or letters from witnesses such as shelter workers, police officers, counselors, therapists, social workers, medical workers
- Counseling records and reports
- Medical records
- Subpoena from courts to testify against the traffickers
- Report of trafficking situation to the Department of Justice
- Certification letter from the Department of Health and Human Services under § 107(b)(1)(E) of the Trafficking Victims Protection Act

- State Department country reports
- Affidavits (a notarized statement), declarations (a statement signed under penalty of perjury), or letters from witnesses such as shelter workers, police officers, counselors, therapists, social workers, medical workers
- Counseling records and reports
- Medical records
