I am writing to request a letter (or, in the alternative, a newly signed I-918 Supplement B) on behalf of Ms. XXXXXXX indicating that she has not refused to cooperate with law enforcement since her original I-918B Certification was obtained in May XXXX. Ms. XXXXXXXX is a U nonimmigrant who is being represented by the Tahirih Justice Center in her application for lawful permanent residency in the United States. As part of her application before U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS), Ms. XXXXXXXX must provide evidence that she did not unreasonably refuse to assist in the ongoing investigation of the criminal case.
