TRANSLATE for Tahirih clients and help decrease language barriers! If you are fluent in a language other than English, you can help a woman or girl access services in the language she is most comfortable. Currently, our greatest need is for English-Spanish interpreters. If you are not available to interpret in person, you can also assist by translating documents remotely!

MOBILIZE our clients by assisting them with transportation. Limited access to public or reliable transportation is a great challenge for our clients and poses a barrier to their representation. Beyond representation, a lack of transportation can make everyday tasks an unnecessary burden such as: accessing centrally-located courts, seeking housing, applying for jobs, accessing medical and mental health clinics, or furthering their education. Connecting a survivor with reliable transportation would mitigate this barrier, broadening a survivor's ability to establish themselves in safety and build a new life.

issues, encouraging them to get involved in their community early on. You can also uplift and amplify the voice of survivors
by calling or writing your Legislators to express your concern for women fleeing violence. Use the following script: "Hello.

protections for courageous immigrant women fleeing violence. Thank you."
