What is the Advisory Board?

A group of leaders in our local community with diverse backgrounds (Philanthropists, CEO's, Attorneys, Medical professionals, etc.) who work with local staff to raise funds, awareness, and advance the mission of Tahirih Justice Center in each region.

Advisory Board Purpose

- Build a network of supporters, and connect Tahirih with individuals, corporations, and foundations that will provide philanthropic support for our mission.
- Actively educate themselves about the issue of gender-based violence and the immigrant women, children, and families Tahirih serves.
- Raise public awareness
- Support staff in generating the revenue necessary to keep local programs up and running.

Our four primary revenue streams:

- 1. Individual donations
- 2. Corporate partnerships
- 3. Foundation grants
- 4. Special events

Annual Member Responsibilities

- Provide advice and guidance to Tahirih Staff
- Seeking publicity opportunities for the Tahirih Justice Center and speaking engagements for its staff
- Participate in advocacy and community outreach with Tahirih Staff as needed
- Participate in at least one fundraising/stewardship event
- Develop a donor prospect list (businesses/individuals)
- Make a personal gift annually
- Attend regular council meetings (minimum of 75%)
- Attend annual orientation to learn Tahirih's mission, purpose, and values.
- Serve a two year term (up to three renewals)
- Recruit new members when applicable
- Aiding in the cultivation of prospective donors and philanthropic opportunities

Paramaters

This is not a governing board and there are no legal or fiduciary responsibilities, and no staffing authority.

Local Member Expectations

In Atlanta, our Advisory Council members are key in the success of our programs and fundraising efforts. We ask each member to commit to the following items, annually:

- Attend at least 3 out of 4 Advisory Council meetings
- Assist with prospecting by introducing your network to Tahirih and working with Tahirih staff with their prospect list
- Seeking publicity opportunities for the Tahirih Justice Center and speaking engagements for its staff (Media interviews, Lunch and Learns with prospective corporate partners, etc.)
- Participate in advocacy and community outreach with Tahirih Staff as needed (tabling events and signing petitions to local Senators)
- Give/Get \$1,500
- Makes a two (2) year commitment

- Secure a corporate sponsorship
- Launch a Facebook fundraiser for your birthday or Giving Tuesday
- Assist in securing a grant from a local foundation
- Host a Friendsgiving event
- Assist with local drives and community resource events
- Start a letter/email writing campaign

- Recruit another Advisory Council member when applicable

The Tahirih Justice Center is a national, nonprofit organization that serves immigrant survivors fleeing gender-based violence. By amplifying the experiences of survivors in communities, courts, and Congress, Tahirih's mission is to create a world in which all people share equal rights and live in safety and with dignity.

We provide each survivor with the resources to obtain the personal protection they are legally entitled to while supporting their autonomy in their healing journey.
